***Riding and Horsemanship
For Girls Scouts
At Twin Lakes Farm!***

Twin Lakes Farm programs for girl scouts earning their badges:

Program I - Horse Fan

\$15.00 per child, groups of four and up.

In an hour-long session, Scouts are given a tour of a working horse farm, learn about the care that horses require and the work that horse professionals do on a daily basis. Scouts see where the horses live, learn about feeding, veterinary care, equine dental care and how to keep a horse healthy, happy and fit. In addition, the Scouts will learn about the equipment needed for both horse and rider, and careers in the horse industry.

Program II - Horse Rider

\$45.00 per child, groups of four and up.

This program lasts one to three hours (depending on the number of Scouts participating) and includes all of Program I, along with a more hands-on practicum that allows the girls to learn about horses through handling them in a safe and controlled environment. Scouts will be given an opportunity to explore "Horsemanship"- both on the ground and in the saddle. The girls are split into small groups and rotate sections. Besides being shown basic riding skills, Scouts learn to groom and tack up the horse, the anatomy of a horse, and are shown in detail the equipment used in riding. Special emphasis is placed on safety practices and on potential careers in horses.

*While these programs are based on the requirements for Junior Badges,
the programs can be tailored to fit the needs of Brownies, Seniors, and Cadettes.*

We are located on California Road on the border between Eastchester and Bronxville. Scouts will need a release form signed by a parent or guardian, long pants, and a shoe with a ½ inch heel, such as a hiking boot. A \$15 or \$45 deposit is required, depending on the program chosen.
